AIRCRAFT MAINTAINENCE

CAPR 66-1 16 DEC 2013 IS SUPPLEMENTED AS FOLLOWS:
PER Par 4

CTWG Maintenance on all aircraft assigned to CTWG will be the responsibility of the Wing Aircraft Maintenance Officer, in order to ensure that all Corporate Aircraft Maintenance is accomplished at the proper time and at an authorized repair facility. The Asst. Wing Maintenance Officer will maintain the aircraft maintenance logbooks and see that the WIMRS database is up to date when maintenance is done on an aircraft. He will review the maintenance status of all wing aircraft, expedite needed repairs or maintenance and keep the Wing Maintenance Officer informer of the status of all actions.

Each squadron will have an Aircraft Maintenance Officer assigned. They will be responsible for inspection of any aircraft at their unit site at the end (Sunday) of each week. They will include the following in their inspections:

- a. Is the aircraft properly secured, i.e. chocked, tied down and doors secured.
- b. Is the AIF book up to date and all proper information entered, sufficient forms in place to execute a flight, cargo compartment secure, Hobbs and Tach no.'s entered

The Aircraft Maintenance Officer will fill out a CTWG Weekly Aircraft report form (60-G) and email this report to the CTWG DO, AMO and AAMO.

On the last day of each month the Aircraft Maintained officer will collect the flight logs from any aircraft at their facility and do an inspection using CAPF 71. Both

flight logs and the inspection form will be scanned and emailed to the CTWG DO by the second day of each month. Original is to be mailed to CTWG HQ.

If there is a CTWG Aircraft stationed at a squadron during an SUI, it will be inspected by the Inspection Team
