

CTWG ENCAMPMENT EQUIPMENT LIST

ABU/BDUs: (*You must bring the following for your ABUs*) BDU's are allowed with a few changes as noted).

- 2 ABU Blouses
- 2 ABU Pants
- 1 pair black combat boots, shined
- 8-10 tan t-shirts without writing or design (black with BDUs)
- 8-10 pairs of black socks (Extra socks are a good idea if you have them)
- 1 ABU belt (Blue mesh with BDU)
- 1 blue name tape already sewn on each blouse
- 1 blue "Civil Air Patrol" tape already sewn on each blouse
- 1 Wing Patch already sewn on each blouse (mandatory by CTWG CC)
- 2 cadet grade insignia on each blouse (1 set metal grade may be switched)
- 8-10 pair appropriate underwear
- Pistol belt with 2 canteens and canteen covers or Camelback type hydration
- Poncho (this item is very important – being wet makes for a miserable day)

Blues: (*You must bring the following for your Blues*)

- 1 Blues shirt - short sleeve
- 1 Blues pants (females may wear skirt)
- 2 pair dress socks - BLACK - or neutral hose for females is authorized
- 1 Blues belt
- 1 Flight cap with hat insignia
- 2 cadet grade insignia
- 1 pair plain black shoes, shined
- 1 set ribbons
- 1 cadet blue nameplate
- 2 V-neck white t-shirts with no writing or design

Toiletries:

- Toothpaste & Toothbrush
- Shampoo
- Soap**
- Deodorant**
- Hairbrush/comb
- Shaving supplies as appropriate
- Foot powder (required for males, strongly recommended for females)
- 2 towels
- 2 wash clothes
- 1 pair shower sandals, flip-flops, etc (We DO NOT shower in bare feet!)**
- 1 Package of moleskin (sold at Walmart and Drugstores)**

PT Uniform:

At least: 3 sets PT clothes - no jeans (females: shorts must go past your finger tips when standing at attention)
3 black Shirts (no pockets, no designs)
3 black athletic shorts
2 pairs running sneakers (one pair for pool - will get wet)

Other Items:

1 set appropriate civilian clothes
1-2 conservative bathing suits (females: one-piece bathing suit)
2 additional pairs of shorts (**Males will be showering with shorts on)
1 set of Twin Sheets (flat and fitted sheet), 1 pillow case (pillow provided), and 1 blanket
1 Helmet (bicycle) with chin strap - you cannot do obstacle course without one
Laundry bag
Clothes hangers (enough for all your uniforms)
Shoe shining material
Sewing kit (blunt tipped scissors only)

Classroom Gear:

Learn to Lead Vol. 1 (put your name in it)
Notebook/paper
Pens/pencils

Miscellaneous Items:

Masking tape
Flashlight with batteries
Insect repellent**
Sunscreen (SPF 15 or higher)***
Lock for locker

***Please remember to include these on your Encampment Application on the Cadet Self-Medication, p. 5.

Everything you bring should have your name on it somewhere so that, if separated from you, it can be returned.

Prohibited Items List

Do NOT Bring Any Of The Following:

- CD Player/Walkman, iPod/iPad/Tablets, Mp3 player
- **Cell Phone**
- Portable radio, TV, stereo, games
- Miscellaneous handheld electronic devices
- Laptop computers
- Guns, knives (including pocket knives), scissors with a point, or any other item that can be considered a weapon - PROHIBITED FOR ALL CAP MEMBERS
- Any non-prescription drugs not listed on the Encampment Application, or illegal drugs
- Alcohol or any tobacco products including Vape items and e-cigarettes - PROHIBITED BY ALL CAP MEMBERS
- Pornography - PROHIBITED BY ALL CAP MEMBERS
- Videos or DVDs
- Any food, drink, gum, etc
- Money over \$25.00

Any student bringing the above items to Encampment will have them confiscated. Possession of some of these items may result in immediate removal from Encampment and other disciplinary action.

There will be an email sent out in regards to prescription medication it is vitally important that you read and follow the instructions in that email. If they are not followed correctly the medication will NOT be able to stay with the cadet until the issues are corrected.
